Introduction to Childbirth 8 hours of instruction; \$150

As a supplement to the required reading, this class will explore the physiology of childbirth that an entry-level birth doula must know. It will clarify any of the childbirth related jargon that doulas often hear as they assist women during this special time. This is <u>NOT</u> a required class and it normally takes place one week prior to the Labor Support Course. <u>Call for dates.</u>

Labor Support Course Formats

3-day Workshop - Friday to Sunday Or Weeknight Workshop - Two nights/week 6:00 - 9:30pm - 6 classes total

In either format, this workshop discusses: In-depth labor support strategies, the role of the doula within the medical framework, guidelines for pre- and post-natal contact with the client, how to deal with problem labors and setting up practice as a doula. The course uses texts, videos, supplementary literature, slides and role-play to build theoretical knowledge and teach practical skills.

Weekend Labor Support Course Format

Friday 2:30 PM to 7:30 PM:

Introductions; Experience at Birth; Group Goal Setting; The Benefits of Birth Doulas; the Doula research; Dona Codes & Ethics and certification; the process of certification and initial client contact.

Saturday and Sunday 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM:

The course content focuses on the physical and psychological processes associated with giving birth and the significance of childbirth in women's lives. The special role of the doula in the prenatal period, during labor and delivery and during the postpartum period is covered in detail. Emphasis is placed on the importance of appropriate, culturally sensitive and ethical support.

Comfort measures are discussed and practiced with role-play and videos to enhance the learning process. Participants learn how to enable women and their partners to cope with both complicated and uncomplicated labors, including surgical birth. We have added a full breastfeeding portion, which covers **DONA's requirement for a 3-hour lactation class.**

** Weeknight Workshop covers exactly the same information, in same # of hours, for the same cost.
